The Safe Babies Program was developed in Victoria by Dr. Lenora Marcellus, in partnership with Capital Regional Health and the Ministry for Children and Families. The program was introduced in response to the increasing need for highly-skilled caregivers who could be trained specifically in meeting the special needs of substance-exposed infants.

To participate in the Safe Babies Training you must be approved by your Resource Social Worker. Participation in all 7 modules is mandatory. If you would like to be considered for approval to attend this training, please contact your Resource Social Worker for more information.
